Sub : Unjustified Transfer of Shri Abhishek C. Kadam-Telecom Helper – Request for Review.

Dear Sir,

With due respect, it is to bring to your kind notice that Shri Abhishek C. Kadam-Telecom Helper working under SSE/TELE/I/PRTN, has been transferred to MYG along with post in-spite of two vacancy at PRTN, vide the reference order mentioned above. This transfer, done without citing any specific reason, has come as a surprise to all staff of the Telecom Department and has caused considerable unrest among them.

Shri Abhishek C. Kadam is a sincere, regular and obedient worker who has been carrying out his duties diligently. His personal circumstances are also deeply concerning - his mother is suffering from breast cancer and is undergoing continuous treatment and follow-up at Railway Hospital, PRTN. Being the sole caretaker of his ailing mother, this sudden transfer poses a severe hardship to his family and appears more as a punishment rather than a routine administrative move.

In light of the above, the union humbly requests you to kindly review the said transfer order in the interest of natural justice and staff welfare. Union sincerely hope that due consideration will be given to the humanitarian aspects involved and appropriate action will be taken to retain Shri Kadam at PRTN.
